Leaders on tenterhooks as countdown to June 4 begins

AS the counting day approaches, anticipation runs high for the results across various constituencies. Candidates and political parties are anxiously awaiting the outcomes, along with the expected timing of each constituency's result.

The counting process will commence at 8 am on June 4, starting with the postal ballots. Given the significant number of employees who utilised the postal ballot facility in 2024 polls, this initial phase may take longer than usual.

Despite the extended time for postal ballot counting, the counting of EVM (Electronic Voting Machine) votes will commence at 8.30 am. Each constituency will have a minimum of 14 counting tables, with more tables added depending on the number of polling booths, candidates and votes cast. According to official sources, results from each round of counting are expected to be available around every 30 minutes. By 10.30 to 11.00 am, 4-5 rounds

- By 10.30 am on the counting day, about 4 rounds may be completed in all constituencies
- In erstwhile Chittoor district, Nagari, Chittoor and Thamballapalle results may come out first as they have 17 rounds
- All constituencies will have 14 tables each for Assembly constituencies and Parliament seat while Chandragiri will have 20 tables each as it has 395 polling booths
- Postal ballot counting to begin at 8 am and even if it is not completed, EVM counting to begin simultaneously at 8.30 am
- At the end, VVPATs of five polling booths in each constituency selected by random draw to be counted before announcing the result

will likely be completed in each constituency, providing early indicators of the final results. However, the official results will only be declared after counting the VVPAT (Voter Verified Paper Audit Trail) slips.

As such, in the erstwhile Chittoor district the Nagari constituency results are

anticipated first, as it has only seven candidates and a smaller voter base. Nagari will be counted in 17 rounds. Almost around the same time, Thamballapalle and Chittoor counting will also be completed in 17 rounds though the number of voters and candidates slightly differ there. They will be followed

by Kuppam in 18 rounds and Punganur, Madanapalle, Puthalapattu and GD Nellore in 19 rounds.

Tirupati and Satyavedu will conclude after 20 rounds, while Srikalahasti, Piler and Palamaner will need 21 rounds. Chandragiri with 395 polling booths, may finish after 20 rounds but will

use 20 counting tables instead of the standard 14 used in the other 13 constituencies. The same number of tables will be used for counting Parliamentary votes in all the constituencies.

After completing the EVM vote count, officials will select five polling stations per constituency through a random draw to count their VVPAT slips before announcing the official results.

If any EVM encounters a technical issue or battery failure, it will be set aside and the VVPATs from those booths will be counted at the end.

Officials expect the entire counting process to be completed between 4 pm and 5 pm on June 4. However, preliminary trends indicating potential winners and the likely formation of the government may be evident by noon.

Still, the people and candidates are eagerly waiting for the exit polls which will be released after 6 pm on June 1 as they may give a broader indication on the formation of the next government in the State and at the Centre as well.

ABV assumes charge as Printing Commissioner, retires on same day

IN a peculiar situation, senior IPS officer A B Venkateswara Rao assumed charge as commissioner of printing, stationary and Stores purchase assumed charge on Friday morning and retired in the evening on the same day.

It may be noted that the State government issued orders on Friday for reinstatement of the IPS officer as the central Administrative

Tribunal (CAT) lifted the suspension orders on AB Venkateswara Rao and directed the State government for the reinstatement of the officer.

Speaking on the occasion, Venkateswara Rao thanked everyone who had supported him and recalled that earlier he took charge as commissioner in the same office two years ago. Again in the same office, he assumed charge on Friday morning and attained superannuation in the evening. "As a government officer

I cannot comment any more on this," he added.

It may be noted that the YSRCP government suspended A B Venkateswara Rao on the charges of irregularities in purchase of security equipment during the previous TDP regime. When ABV challenged his suspension in CAT, the State government filed petition in the Supreme Court challenging the CAT orders. However, following the orders of Supreme Court, the State government issued

posting orders and later suspended him. The CAT issued orders for reinstatement of ABV on May 8. However the government dodged the issue of his reinstatement and again filed petition on CAT orders in High Court. The HC too ruled in favour of ABV.

ABV handed over the orders of CAT to Chief Secretary and Chief Electoral Officer two days back. The Chief Secretary issued orders for reinstatement of ABV on Thursday.

ACB arrests two police officers for accepting bribe

HYDERABAD: THE Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) officials apprehended two police officers under the Rachakonda Police Commissionerate and private persons for demanding and accepting a bribe of Rs 3 lakh from a person.

Among those arrested are Kushaiguda police station circle Inspector G Veera Swamy and sub-inspector Shaik Shafi. Both, through a private person, Upender, demanded a bribe of Rs 3 lakh from Singireddy Bharat Reddy for official favour in a case registered against him.

With Cong in power, TS gearing up for a different Formation Day celebration

HYDERABAD: The 10th Formation Day of Telangana will be different from the earlier occasions, with both ruling Congress and main Opposition Bharat Rashtira Samithi (BRS) vying with each other to celebrate it in a befitting manner. This is the first Telangana Formation Day celebration after BRS lost power to the Congress.

While the Congress is going all out to organise a grand celebration by inviting its top leader Sonia Gandhi, the BRS has also lined up a series of events to mark the occasion.

Ever since Telangana came into existence in 2014, both Congress and BRS have been claiming credit for its formation.

While the Congress says that it was the initiative of the United Progressive Alliance (UPA) which realised the long-cherished dream of the people of Telangana,

TRS (now BRS) maintains that the credit goes to its leader K Chandrababoo Naidu (KCR), who led the mass movement, forcing then Congress-led UPA government to carve out the state.

Victory in the 2014 elections, held a few weeks before the formal creation of Telangana state, gave TRS a chance to position itself as the champion of the Telangana cause. It projected itself as the only party dedicated to the cause of Telangana's development and welfare.

By retaining power in 2018, KCR further consolidated his position. However, the victory in Assembly elections held in November 2023 has finally given a chance to the Congress to stake claim for Telangana's creation.

The Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy-led government appears to be making full use of this opportunity. In every election held since

2014, the Congress projected Sonia Gandhi as the 'mother of Telangana' who heard the people's voice and fulfilled their aspirations.

Its leaders tried to impress upon the people that she carved out Telangana state despite knowing fully well that the Congress will suffer politically in Andhra Pradesh. In the recent elections, Revanth and other Congress leaders had urged the people to bring the Congress to power as their gratitude to Sonia 'amma' (mother) for delivering a separate state for them. It's no wonder that after coming to power the Congress decided to invite former party chief, Sonia Gandhi, to the main event to be held on June 2.

The state Cabinet decided to felicitate her in recognition of the key role played by her in the formation of the state. CM Reddy visited Delhi a few days ago to invite her and she accepted the invitation. Sonia

Gandhi will participate in the main event at Parade Ground Secunderabad with the hoisting of the national flag, a parade and a march past by police contingents. This will be her second visit to Telangana after Congress stormed to power in the state.

She along with former Congress chief, Rahul Gandhi and senior leader Priyanka Gandhi, had attended the swearing-in ceremony of the Chief Minister and his Cabinet colleagues on December 7 at LB Stadium.

CM Reddy had arrived for the oath-taking ceremony with Sonia Gandhi in a flower-bedecked open-top vehicle. At the state formation day celebrations, the Congress government will also felicitate those who participated in the movement for Telangana state.

It is likely to honour those who sidelined by the BRS government. Political analysts say as KCR dominated the politics of India's

youngest state for the last 10 years and built his image as 'father of Telangana', CM Reddy is keen to counter this narrative.

It's for this reason that CM Reddy reversed the decisions of the BRS government. He replaced 'TS' with 'TG' as the state's abbreviation.

The Congress government also approved a new state anthem, which will be released at the formation day event. CM Revanth also wanted to unveil a new emblem in place of the existing one designed by the KCR government. However, his move to remove Kakatiya Kala Thoranam (Kakatiya arch) and Charminar from the emblem ran into problems with the BRS threatening state-wide protests.

As the All India Majlis-e-Ittehadul Muslimeen (AIMIM) too opposed the move to remove Charminar, the Congress government dropped plans to unveil a new emblem saying a decision will be taken after discussion in the Assembly. The Chief Minister has already decided to have a new statue of 'Telangana Thalli' (mother Telangana), replacing the one designed by the previous government.

The BRS has also announced plans to celebrate the state formation day with three-day-long festivities.

The BRS leaders will take out a candlelight rally from Telangana Martyrs' Memorial at Gun Park to the Amara Jyoti memorial built by the BRS government in honour of those who sacrificed their lives in the Telangana movement.

Social security pensions to be distributed in two modes

The pension distribution will start on June 1 and continue up to June 5

PRINCIPAL Secretary of Panchayat Raj and Rural Development Shashibhushan Kumar announced here on Friday that the social security pensions for the month of May payable in June would be distributed in two modes — direct benefit transfer and door-to-door disbursement.

The State government has released an amount of Rs 1939.35 crore towards disbursement of pension to 65,30,838 pensioners across the State.

Out of 65,30,838 pensioners, 47,74,733 pensions (73.11 per cent) will be released through DBT mode and the pension amount will be credited into the pensioner's account on June 1.

Pensioners can withdraw cash at their convenience.

The rest of 17,56,105 pensions (26.89 per cent) will be released through door-to-door disbursement. All village/ward secretariats have drawn cash on May 31 and will start door-to-door disbursement of pensions from June 1. The pension distribution will start on June 1 and continue up to June 5.

The Principal Secretary said that necessary instructions have been issued to the District Collectors and banks to make adequate arrangements for the convenience of the pensioners, so that they receive their pensions without any hardship, inconvenience and in time, duly following the Model Code of Conduct.
